

MAY COURT CLUB OF CHATHAM WOMEN OF EXCELLENCE 2018

SUMMARY



Eligibility

To be eligible for the May Court's Women of Excellence Award, nominees must fulfil all the following criteria:

- Be living and be 30 years of age or older (exception is the Young Woman of Excellence category where nominees must be 18 – 29 years of age)
- Have lived or worked in Chatham-Kent (not necessarily currently living or working here)
- Not be a current elected public office holder
- Be able to attend the Awards Dinner on Thursday, May 24, 2018

Guidelines

Nominees will be evaluated within their category according to these guidelines:

- Recognition by peers/colleagues and/or general population as having reached a high level of accomplishment/expertise in her chosen field locally, provincially, nationally or internationally
- Demonstrated her ability to be a role model for others
- Contributed to the development of others through mentoring, coaching, teaching or by example
- Contributed to the community through development of new or existing programs or services and has shown a commitment to service within the local, regional, national or international community

Categories

Arts and Culture

Recognized for patronage of or contribution to the arts (visual, literary or performing), cultural diversity or heritage of the community

Business and Professions

Recognized for achievement in a business or profession in the public, private or non-profit sector

Community and Volunteerism

Recognized for contribution through voluntary commitment to the development or enhancement of programs or humanitarian efforts which benefit the local, regional, national or international community

Education and Training

Recognized for contribution through the practice of teaching, research or administration in education, training and development or alternative learning programs

Health, Science and Technology

Recognized for contribution to the field of health and wellness, medicine, science or technology

Young Woman of Excellence (18 – 29 years of age)

Recognized for commitment, achievement and leadership in her chosen environment, whether through school, community or workplace

Nomination Process

Note the following regarding the Nomination Process for all Women of Excellence categories:

- Nomination forms, together with accompanying material addressing the Women of Excellence guidelines, should be mailed to:

- Nomination forms must be signed by both the nominee and the nominator
- Current members of the May Court Club of Chatham are not eligible to nominate or be nominated for the Women of Excellence Awards
- The closing date for receipt of all nominations by the May Court Club of Chatham is Monday, March 26, 2018. All nominations received by the deadline will be acknowledged by email (where available) or by a letter to the nominee and nominator

Selection Process

Note the following regarding the Selection Process for all Women of Excellence categories:

- All nomination forms will be treated in confidence
- The Selection Committee reserves the right to reclassify a nominee to a more appropriate category
- All nominees will be informed of the Committee's decisions starting on April 12, 2018
- Honourees will be announced at a media event in Chatham on April 23, 2018
